Registration is earlier this year so please mark your calendars. Registration dates and times are listed below. You are always welcome to call the office if you have questions about registration. Please see attached supply lists for students in grades 7-12.

**Online registration** opens July 27<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 am. The link for online registration will be available on the school website and emailed to all current Carroll families.

**Onsite registration** dates and times are as follows:

Wednesday, July 27<sup>th</sup> 8:00 am – 12:00 pm

Thursday, July 28<sup>th</sup> 1:00 pm – 7:00 pm

Friday, July 29<sup>th</sup> 1:00 pm – 5:00 pm

**Grade 7 Orientation** is Thursday, July 28<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 pm in the Carroll High School Auditorium. Students will meet their core team of teachers and tour the building. Everyone is encouraged to attend. This is such an exciting time for our incoming 7<sup>th</sup> grade students.

**Supply Lists** – We have attached a supply list to this letter. If there are additional supplies, teachers will communicate specific needs at the start of the school year. Basic folders, binders, notebooks, pencils and pens are used by all students. A backpack is recommended for all students.

**Ipad Distribution** – Students will receive iPads once school begins. All permission forms must be turned in for a student to receive an iPad, so remember to complete all required signature forms during the registration process.

**First Day of School** is Monday, August 8th. Classes will begin at 8:00 am and conclude at 3:09 pm.

**Meet the Teacher Night** is scheduled **Monday, August 15<sup>th</sup>** beginning at 6:30 p.m. and ending at 8:00 pm.

**Payment Information** – Cash, checks and debit/credit cards are accepted at registration. Textbook and lunch assistance program applications are available at registration.

**Athletic passes** – Student and family passes allow entrance to most athletic events. Families can sign up to work at athletic events to pay for athletic passes. More detailed information is available at registration.

**Senior Parking Spaces:** Seniors were given information about this at the beginning of the summer. If you have any questions, please ask Tina Miller in the main office. Paint your own space! July 30<sup>th</sup> & 31<sup>st</sup> 9:00am-9:00 pm.
