

SCHOOL-AGE CHILD-CARE PROGRAM

In accordance with I.C.20-26-5-2, as from time to time amended, the Carroll Consolidated School Corporation will conduct an after-school child-care program that is available to all children in Kindergarten through sixth grade. The program(s) will be conducted in Carroll Consolidated School Corporation buildings, but may be operated by independent, not-for-profit or for-profit organizations other than the Carroll Consolidated Schools. Any contracted entity providing services for operation of the program shall be required to obtain liability insurance in minimal amounts acceptable to the Carroll Consolidated School Corporation. Maximum adult-to-child ratios for the program shall be adhered to for the overall supervision and enrichment opportunities of the children being served. No rental fees will be assessed for use of facilities, however, parents may be charged reasonable fees to reimburse Carroll Consolidated School Corporation for personnel, utilities, maintenance, or other added costs directly attributable to the operation of the child-care program.

If the Carroll Consolidated School Corporation experiences undue hardship due to a low number of eligible children utilizing the school child-care program, then pursuant to I.C.20-26-5-2(c), as amended from time to time, the school corporation may receive a waiver from the Indiana State Board of Education for conducting the school child-care program.
